

**Pre-employment check  
Children's Barred List – Regulated Activity**

**Please Note: this flowchart does NOT apply when checking eligibility for the Adult's Barred List**

**Regulated Activity is defined as**

- a) teaching, training, instructing, caring for (see (c) below) or supervising children if the person is unsupervised, or providing advice or guidance on well-being, or driving a vehicle only for children,

**OR**

- b) work for a limited range of establishments (known as 'specified places', which include schools and colleges), with the opportunity for contact with children, but not including work done by supervised volunteers;

**OR**

- c) relevant personal care, or health care provided by or provided under the supervision of a health care professional:
- personal care includes helping a child, for reasons of age, illness or disability, with eating or drinking, or in connection with toileting, washing, bathing and dressing;
  - health care means care for children provided by, or under the direction or supervision of, a regulated health care professional.

**Work under a) or b) is regulated activity only if done 'regularly' and regularly is defined as at least one of the following:**

- **Frequently** (once a week or more often) or
- **Intensively** (on 4 or more days in a 30 day period) or
- **Overnight** (between 2-6am) even once and with an opportunity for face-to-face contact with children.

**Work under c) is always regulated activity regardless of its frequency or whether the individual is supervised or not.**
