

## **Oxfordshire Post-16 Provider Network Terms of Reference**

**Name of Group:** Oxfordshire Post-16 Provider Network

**Purpose:**

- To meet the post-16 educational needs of young people living in Oxfordshire with Special Educational Needs / Disabilities
- To realise the full educational post-16 potential of young people with Special Educational Needs / Disabilities
- To establish concrete partnership working between post-16 providers, young people and their families, that focuses on individual need and outcomes for young people living in Oxfordshire such as employment and greater independence
- To work together to make best use of available funding to provide a wide range of post-16 educational experiences
- To disseminate national and local information
- To provide a forum for discussion, problem solving and the sharing of outstanding practice
- To identify shared training needs and support new projects as they are designed and implemented

**Geographical Area:** Oxfordshire

**Membership:** All post-16 providers of education and training to young people with Special Educational Needs / Disabilities, schools, Work Based Learning, voluntary and community sector providers.

Once fully established, the OPPN will deliver a yearly programme open for any interested party to join the group on that date.
