

Key Stage 2 Tests

The Data

There are no changes in Key Stage 2 Test data between 2018 and 2019.

Pupils will have scaled scores, which are normalised values, a score of 100 will be considered the expected standard.

Pupils will take tests in grammar, punctuation & spelling, reading and maths. They will be awarded raw scores for those tests and the DfE will release conversion tables to produce scaled scores from those raw scores.
