

SAFE! would like to offer the opportunity for young people aged 13 to 17 who identify as LGBTQIA+,

who have experienced domestic abuse within their own romantic relationships or have witnessed domestic abuse within their family, to take part in the DAY Programme.

DAY is a unique multimedia programme that uses short films, advertisements and chart music to raise awareness and provide education about healthy and unhealthy relationships in a relevant and exciting way.

All sessions will take place via Zoom.

Young people will have one or two 1-2-1
sessions with a SAFE project worker,
prior to 8 weekly group sessions and an activity
in half term.

DAY is based on the Freedom Programme but is designed to be used with young people of all genders.

Each young person will need to be able to access Zoom, in a private and safe space, with an adult available in the home to offer support if needed.
