

## Key Stage 1 2023

### The Data

In Key Stage 1 in 2023, schools will continue to use the Engagement Model for pupils below the standard of the Key Stage.

There is a range of possible performance categories for each subject, you can see these illustrated in the table below.

The target for every child is to be working at the expected standard (EXS). However, there are categories for those working at greater depth (GDS). For those working lower than the expected standard (WTS, HNM, PK1–PK4, EM).

Reading, writing and maths have the same categories. Science does not have a greater depth outcome and everything below the Expected Standard is recorded as Has Not Met (HNM).

The table below shows the data items collected for each child.
