Priority action plan published to improve SEND services

Oxfordshire County Council has published the <u>local area</u> <u>partnership priority action plan</u> to improve services and support for children and young people with special educational needs and disabilities (SEND). A <u>news story</u> <u>for the publication of the PAP</u> has been published.

The plan responds to Ofsted and the Care Quality Commission's inspection report of SEND partnership services in July. A draft plan was submitted to the Department for Education (DfE) on 24 October and was approved by Ofsted on 12 December.
