



## Invitation to join a joint research pilot project

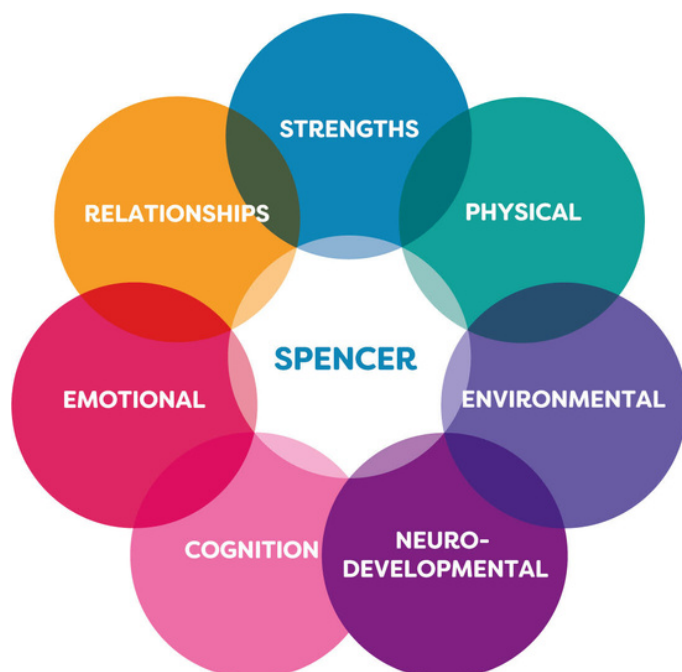
In conjunction with Berkshire Healthcare NHS Foundation Trust and the University of Reading, Spencer3D would like to invite schools to participate in a research pilot project to evaluate the impact and effectiveness of the SPENCER Professional tool in supporting schools with the mental health, learning and cognitive development of learners.

SPENCER Professional is a web-based tool which seeks to re-frame the behaviours you see in learners in your school, to help you understand and provide support for those learners through a range of practical strategies for use in the classroom.

Using psychological formulation algorithms, SPENCER Professional takes your responses to a questionnaire about observed behaviours and provides you with a profile for that learner.

Created by a multi-disciplinary team including education and clinical psychologists, CAMHS experts, speech and language therapists and SENCOs, the tool considers the whole learner. The recommendations empower teachers to support learners with a wide range of different needs in the classroom setting.

For school leaders and SENDCOs, the profiles provide a understanding of the types of needs which are common across cohorts and the whole school, supporting leaders in developing their strategic plans for staff deployment and development, as well as informing policy and practice changes.
