### SENSS Assistive Technology 'Quick Tip': Mouse Pointers and Text Cursors in Chromebooks

**Q:** How can we make it easier to see the computer Mouse Pointer and Text Cursor in Chromebooks?

**A:** In Chromebook settings you can change your Mouse Pointer to be a larger size, as well as highlighted when it moves. You can also set the Text Cursor to be highlighted when it moves.

#### How to make the Mouse Pointer easier to see on your Chromebook:

1. Click the Time widget in the bottom right corner of the screen then click the Settings button.



2. In the Settings window, select 'Accessibility' from the left-hand column



3. Click 'Cursor and touchpad' in the right-hand panel.

4. Click the toggle switch next to 'Highlight the mouse cursor when it's moving', in order to increase the visibility of the Mouse Pointer by putting a red halo around it.



5. Click the toggle switch next to 'Show large mouse cursor', in order to increase the size of the Mouse Pointer.



#### How to make the Text Cursor easier to see on your Chromebook:

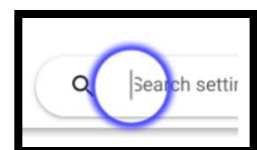
1. Click the Time widget in the bottom right corner of the screen then click the Settings button.

2. In the Settings window, select 'Accessibility' from the left-hand column.



3. Click 'Keyboard and text input' in the right-hand panel.

4. Click the toggle switch next to 'Highlight the text caret when it appears or moves', in order to increase the visibility of the Text Cursor by putting a blue halo around it.
