Skills Builder Partnership is a social enterprise.


We exist because we know the transformative power of essential skills across an individual's lifetime. These skills boost wellbeing, earnings, and halve the likelihood of being out of work or employment.

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Adopt the Skills Builder Universal Framework

The product of five years' cutting-edge research and design, the Skills Builder Universal Framework makes it possible for everyone to teach, learn, and measure essential skills.

The Framework breaks each of the eight skills down into a sequence of steps, taking individuals from being an absolute beginner through to mastery. We call them essential, because that's what they are. The Framework puts rigour behind the highly transferrable skills needed to do almost any job.



How Impact organisations use the Framework

There are 16 steps for each skill, allowing your organisation the flexibility to select which skills and steps are most useful for you to support your beneficiaries to develop.

Impact organisations often use the Framework's steps for their:

- Learning outcomes
- Success criteria
- · Monitoring and evaluation indicators

Skills Builder Impact Academy

The Impact Academy provides small^{*}, impact-led organisations with a series of training sessions to embed essential skill development within your programme or provision.

Your Skills Leader will join a cohort of other organisations on a journey to Impact Level accreditation for one of your programmes. Your programme will then feature on the Impact Directory.

As well as honing and demonstrating the impact of essential skills in your work, the Impact Academy also provides networking and professional development opportunities for your Skills Leader.

The Impact Academy provides you with a series of online training sessions. You will work as part of a cohort for 3-4 months, as part of your 12 month membership to the Skills Builder Partnership. You will also have access to a Members Pack which includes all the useful links, tools, resources and the preparation you can do before each training session.

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Session overview and objectives

Each session has been designed to support and empower your Skills Leader on their journey to honing and demonstrating the impact of essential skills in your work. Engaging with the Skills Builder team and other like-minded organisations in their cohort, your Skills Leader will be equipped with the knowledge, tools and resources to make programme changes and achieve an Impact Level accreditation.

Session 1: Connect

- Introduction to Skills Builder Partnership and the Universal Framework
- Understand the Impact Levels and what your programme can achieve
- Explore Skills Builder tools and resources and how these support programmes

Session 2: Build

- Share and reflect on changes made so far and progress made on your action plan
- Discuss successes and challenges in making programme changes
- Explore best practice case studies and how these apply to your work
- Review programme changes to consolidate your action plan to achieve an Impact Level

Session 3: Achieve

- Share your programme changes with your cohort peers and celebrate successes
- Evaluate changes and assess against Impact Level descriptors
- Discuss best practice and any additional changes needed (now and in the future)
- Review evidence submission and accreditation process
- Discuss the next steps and ongoing partnership options

Strategic support and accreditation

Skills Builder Universal Impact Level Accreditation is awarded to partners who have successfully embedded the Skills Builder Framework into their provision. This is a result of the impact your programme or provision has for your beneficiaries. For a complete overview of Impact Levels, view our Impact Guide.

During the Impact Academy you will discuss the Impact Levels, criteria and application process in detail. The training sessions are designed with the goal of achieving an Impact Level for one of your programmes. During your one-to-one check-in and progress meeting with Skills Builder, you will be able to discuss your progress towards applying for an Impact Level.



Once achieved, your programme or provision will feature in our Impact Directory. This is shared regularly with the Skills Builder Partnership including our network of education institutions and employers and contributes towards our collective impact mission.

Accredited programmes featured on the Impact Directory must be from Skills Builder Partners.
