Keeping governor data current

This is the annual reminder to maintained schools that your governor data on GovernorHub needs to be kept up to date.


A reminder of details which need to be maintained on GovernorHub:

- Name, email address, and contact number for all governors
- Role and term dates for each governor on the Constitution page
- Assignment of role of Chair/Vice Chair/Clerk on the Roles page
- Committee Chairs and committee membership
- Link governor roles (at minimum, safeguarding and finance)



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The removal of governors' accounts from GovernorHub whose terms of office have expired is also vitally important from a confidentiality and GDPR point of view.

Please also ensure that the school's website and <u>Get Information About</u> <u>Schools</u> is also up to date. Whilst these are usually updated by the school, responsibility for the accuracy of the data remains with governors.

Headteacher pay recommendations
