A reminder to maintained schools that your governor data on GovernorHub needs to be kept up to date.

A reminder of details which need to be maintained on GovernorHub:

- Name, email address, and contact number for all governors
- Role and term dates for each governor on the Constitution page
- Assignment of role of Chair/Vice Chair/Clerk on the Roles page
- Committee Chairs and committee membership
- Link governor roles (at minimum, safeguarding and finance)

Please also ensure that the **school's website** and <u>Get Information</u>


<u>About Schools</u> is also up to date. Whilst these are usually updated by the school, responsibility for the accuracy of the data remains with governors.




Governor Services training programmes
