

Training for Secondary Schools: Suicide Prevention and Postvention Response

The training is for: Members of SLT or those that have a lead on the wellbeing of students. It is designed for staff who support with policy making, guidance and systems in schools. This training is to support SLTs to plan for a mentally healthy school environment to prevent suicides, and to feel prepared if they are required to respond to a suicide in the school community.

We recommend two members of staff from each school attend if possible.

Suicide Prevention:

Learn why there is a focus on this area currently, what are the risk factors and how can schools provide protective factors to counterbalance the risks.

We will discuss audit tools for your school and an example policy that you could use to implement an action plan for suicide prevention.

Postvention (after a suicide):

Learn why schools need to have a different plan for death by suicide compared with other sad events. We will provide you with a Postvention Response Plan and checklist, with guidance notes and scripts so that you are prepared fully to support healing and prevent further suicides.
